This site was located in Sundarban area alongside the bank of the Bidyadhari River in the Nazat-II Gram Panchayat of Sandeshkhali-I Block, in the North 24 Parganas District, West Bengal. On this special occasion, 20,000 mangrove saplings were planted as an initiative to prevent land erosion, safeguard the local community against the damages caused by floods, particularly during the rainy seasons, and foster environmental conservation. #### **Teachers' Day Celebration**


