# AICTE Approval Granted to Bandhan School of Business, Shantiniketan

The Bandhan School of Business, Santiniketan, under Bandhan has received official approval from the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for the academic year 2025-26. The approval has been granted in accordance with the provisions under the AICTE (Grant of Approvals for Technical Institutions) Regulations, 2020, notified vide F. No. AB/AICTE/REG/2020 dated 4th February 2020 and amended on 24th February 2021, under the AICTE Act of 1987. Under this approval, Bandhan School of Business is permitted to offer the following Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) programmes: PGDBM (Business Management), PGDB&FM (Banking and Finance Management), PGDBAM (Business Analytics) – 60 seats in each Programme.

As a part of Bandhan's Healthy Baby Wealthy Nation (HBWN Phase -IV ) project supported by HDFC Life the health team organised a Thalassemia screening camp in partnership with the Jhargram District Health Department.

- 193 students were screened at a local school.

This initiative aimed to build long-term awareness among adolescents and encourage early health-seeking behaviour.

- Inspired students to pursue both vocational and academic opportunities confidently




# Industry Exposure Visit – Domino's Pizza, Patna (April 29, 2025)

# Job Fairs & Counselling Drives – West Bengal (April–June 2025)










In partnership with the Directorate of Employment, Govt. of West Bengal, Bandhan hosted career fairs in:
