The primary goal of this workshop was to raise awareness and promote a safe, inclusive, and respectful work environment for all employees. The workshop featured insights of experts namely, Ms. Sanju Singh, Advocate at Patna High Court, Mr. Ram Manohar Vikas, Advocate at Gujarat High Court, and Dr. Brijesh Rai, RTI Activist, who shared their expertise and knowledge with the attendees. The session was attended by field teams, State teams, and PMU teams of the SJY programme.



MOU Signed with BOSCH Foundation:



Bandhan Employing the Unemployed Programme (EUP) arranged a partners' meet for BRIDGE training programme on 27th November 2024 at Hotel Hindustan International (HHI) in Kolkata, West Bengal. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between BOSCH India Foundation and Bandhan-Konnagar. It formally established the collaboration to provide skill development training and initiatives to empower young people and improving their employability. Ms. Sakina Baker, CSR Head, BOSCH India and other designated BOSCH officials, as well as representatives from other partner organizations and project stakeholders, were among the important individuals who attended the event.

Mega Job Fair 2024

On 7th December 2024, a Mega Job Fair 2024 was organised by Bandhan Skill Development Center (BSDC), Uttarpara, West Bengal under Bandhan Employing the Unemployed Programme to create an incredible platform for job seekers and employers to connect. It was attended by 123 candidates highlighting their inquisitiveness regarding qualification and skills required to crack a particular interview process. Prominent employers, including Fusion BPO, Writer Information, Dewars Garage (Nexa), Canon Digital, and Shriram Finance, joined the event. 70 candidates participated in the recruiting drive, which marked a significant milestone in fostering job possibilities and professional development.



Orientation sessions on Menstrual Hygiene Management



Bandhan Health Programme conducted orientation sessions on Menstrual Hygiene Management for adolescent girls aged 14-18 years across 78 High Schools within the ENHANCE project areas in Sawai Madhopur and Tonk districts in Rajasthan, supported by Kotak Mahindra Bank. Additionally, orientation sessions were organised in 18 schools under the TCTD I project in Ajmer district in Rajasthan, supported by Bajaj Finance Ltd. This effort underscores a broader commitment to empowering young girls and enhancing their well-being. These sessions aimed to educate the girls on menstrual health, hygiene practices, and the importance of proper menstrual care.

Bandhan celebrated Children's Day on 14th November 2024 across all 728 BECs and 8 Academies under its Bandhan Education Programme. The children demonstrated their talents through a variety of acts, including drawing competitions, songs, dances, and recitations, which made the event bright and memorable.

Mangrove Plantation at Basanti and Expansion Plans for Coastal Sustainability:

On 12th December 2024, a mangrove plantation drive was arranged by Bandhan Climate Action Programme in collaboration with the Local Climate Action Group in Chandra Kona Village, Basanti Block, South 24 Parganas District, West Bengal beside the Hogla River. A total of 5,000 Bine (*Avicenna officinalis*) mangrove saplings were planted to fight climate change and promote environmental protection. Local Gram Panchayat dignitaries witnessed the efforts toward creation of climate resilient society.

Bandhan Education Programme (BEP) organised an annual cultural programme across all 10 academies throughout the months of October and November 2024. In these events assets (farm & non-farm) were given as grant to the selected ultra-poor women under these projects to develop enterprises. Henceforth, handholding and mentoring support will be given for two years to get rid of the poverty and becoming self-reliant.

Bandhan's Water Conservation Model :



Bandhan Climate Action Programme (BCAP) launched a water conservation model that made a big difference for local farmers at Kashipur block, in Purulia district, West Bengal. This facilitated in storing water supporting Rabi cultivation on 138 Bighas of land. The goal of this initiative is to help farmers use water more efficiently, expand their agricultural areas, and improve crop production. The stored water was distributed across nearby farms, with several villages and Farmer Field School (FFS) working together to make sure it was used properly for different crops. This approach has helped farmers increase their yields, reduce water stress and making better use of their land.

Leadership Development Programme in Microfinance Management :

In collaboration with the Banking Finance and Insurance Institute of Nepal (BFIN), Bandhan School of Development Management (BSDM) organised a week-long Leadership Development Programme in Microfinance Management from 2nd – 6th December 2024. This residential program focused on building the capacity of middle and senior-level officials involved in policy planning within Microfinance Institutions (MFIs). The programme began with an inauguration attended by Bandhan-Konnagar's senior team, including Mr. Ronendra Chowdhury, Programme Director; Mr. Soumen Mitra, Advisor; and Prof. Jayanta Biswas, Head-Education



It included classroom sessions led by experienced industry experts and field visits. Participants visited the Utrayan Financial Services branch in Diamond Harbour, West Bengal. During the training, participants had the opportunity to explore Kolkata's landmarks, including the Swaminarayan Temple, Belur Math, Dakshineswar Temple, Victoria Memorial, New Market, and the Kolkata Metro. The programme concluded with a closing session and the distribution of certificates to the participants, marking the event's success.

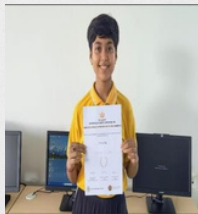


Iron Deficiency Day
